Aspect of Survival	Riva	Anne	Which character was this worse for and why?
Contact with parents	Riva's father died before the Holocaust. Her mother was taken away because she was sick. Riva became legal parent to brothers at age 16.	Anne got to be with both of her parents in hiding until they were sent to camps.	Riva - no parents, had to act as a mother to her 3 younger brothers.
Ability to roam outside	Riva could go outside, but had to be careful.	Anne had to stay in hiding in the attic. "Secret Annex"	Anne - stuck in a small attic with a lot of people.
Access to food	Only given a small ration of bread or soup.	Her family got deliveries from their German friends.	Riva - small rations of bread.
Dealing with disease	Malnourished, not enough food or vitamins very weak brothers had to trade some food for tangerine / vitamins	Anne was in good health before camps.	Riva - malnourished, swollen legs. No medicine.
Area lived in (location)	The Ghetto Lodz, Poland	Attic (Secret Annex) Germany	<del>Poland</del> Riva - "The Cage" Horrible treatment to Jews.
Living conditions	Got to stay in home until moved to old grocery store. Had to hide in cellar when Jewish police came for them.	Got to live in small building with her family. Limited food. Got medicine when sick.	Riva - treated poorly. No medicine when sick.
